Please accept this letter in support of the comments made by Massachusetts Community Media, Inc. ("MASSACCESS") "In the Matter of Implementation of Section 621(a)(1) of the Cable Communications Policy Act of 1984 as Amended by the Cable Television Consumer Protection and Competition Act of 1992."

Braintree Community Access Media (BCAM) is the local access media corporation that was formed to provide local community programming. They provide a valuable service to the residents of our community. Since its inception, BCAM has received funding from multiple cable service providers that provide cable service to Braintree residents.

Any change in what applies to the franchise fee cap would negatively impact BCAM and how it obtains its funding. This would put future programming and the existence of BCAM in jeopardy.
