Dear Mr. Gross:

I am upset about the recent showing of political ads with dead aborted fetuses on TV in Colorado by Matt Noah who was candidate for the U.S. Senate. I don't believe that there should be different standards for political ad content from non-political ad or normal programming content.

If there are restrictions on material unacceptable for children's time, day time, prime time, or evening time, those same restrictions should apply to political ads shown during those times. A group which cannot normally buy time for certain messages and material should not be able to get around restrictions by finding (or putting up) a candidate willing to endorse those messages and material.

I support changing current FCC regulations to permit television stations to apply the same standards and restrictions to political ad content as to non-political ads and general programming content.




