MASS MEDIA BUREAU'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE FURTHER COMMENTS

1. On March 17, 1992, Positive Alternative Radio, Inc. ("Radio") petitioned for leave to amend its application to specify a new transmitter site. While the Mass Media Bureau filed comments in support of Radio's amendment, Triad Family Network, Inc. ("Triad") opposed Radio's amendment on March 26, 1993, arguing, among other things, that Radio's proposal is technically flawed.


2. The Mass Media Bureau has completed its analysis of the Engineering Statement which accompanied Triad's opposition. Although the Commission's rules do not provide for the filing of comments on an opposition pleading, the Bureau submits that it is
