ORDER

Issued: May 5, 1993; Released: May 6, 1993

Under consideration is the Petition to Enlarge the Issues Against KR Partners, filed by KES Communications, Inc. (KES) on March 25, 1993; the Mass Media Bureau's Opposition to Petition to Enlarge Issues, filed on April 12, 1993; the Statement for the Record, filed by KES on April 15, 1993; and the Joint Motion to Withdraw Petition to Enlarge the Issues Against KR Partners, filed by KES and KR Partners (KR) on April 14, 1993.

KES and KR jointly seek to withdraw KES' petition to enlarge the issues which sought the designation of an environmental issue against KR's application.

Movants have properly established in their joint motion that KES's petition was filed in error under the mistaken belief that KR had not filed a correct environmental statement with its application. All pertinent parties, including the Bureau, now agree that there is no basis for the designation of an environmental issue against KR. Accordingly, KES will be granted leave to withdraw its Petition to Enlarge the Issues Against KR Partners, filed by KES on March 25, 1993. SO ORDERED.
