INTEGRATION/DIVERSIFICATION STATEMENT

1. **Ownership Structure:** Corporation with voting and non-voting stock
2. **Ownership:** (a) Ardeth S. Frizzell-100% of voting stock
(b) Thomas J. Beauvais-100% of non-voting stock
3. **Integration:** Ardeth S. Frizzell will work at the station. She will be general manager overseeing all aspects of the station's operation, including sales, programming, personnel, business, etc. All personnel will report to her, either directly or through intermediate supervisors. She intends to devote a minimum of 40 hours per week on a daily basis to this position. She intends to relinquish any then-existing business interests or employment in order to effectuate this commitment.
4. **Media Interests:**
 - (a) Ardeth S. Frizzell has no other media interests
 - (b) Thomas J. Beauvais is a principal of P&G Media Corporation, licensee of WBTZ, Pinconning, Michigan. P&G is a wholly-owned subsidiary of The Patten Corporation. Mr. Beauvais is a 50% owner of The Patten Corporation. The Patten Corporation has a one-half equity interest, in the form of non-voting stock, in Stanton Broadcasting Corporation, permittee of a new FM station at Trussville, Alabama. Mr. Beauvais is 50% owner of GT Leasing, Incorporated which has an 80% ownership interest in WFGR, Grand Rapids, Michigan.
5. **Minority/Female Credit:** Ardeth S. Frizzell claims credit for female status, recognizing that the FCC does not presently recognize a female preference.
6. **Local Residence/Civic Involvement:** Ardeth S. Frizzell's residence at 164 Greener Road, Columbus, Ohio, is within the area to be served by the station, although barely outside the 1 mv/m contour. While at WBBY, Ardeth Frizzell was instrumental in drives to collect shoes for the homeless in 1990 and 1991. She also helped to raise funds for TV Discovery Playground, and for Childrens Hospital.

7. **Broadcast Experience:** Ardeth S. Frizzell was employed at Radio Stations WCOL/WXGT, Columbus, Ohio, from November 1973 to March of 1985. From 1973 to 1976, she was a market research assistant, collecting, compiling and preparing research information for sales presentations. From 1976 to 1989, she was promotion assistant, responsible for detail and follow through on promotions. This included all paper work and control of the contest or promotion as well as prize inventory. From 1978 to 1982, she was assistant bookkeeper at the station. From 1982 to 1985, she was computer coordinator/traffic assistant, overseeing all computer operations, including scheduling of work time between traffic and accounting departments, as well as responsible for all weekly and monthly billing invoices.

In March 1985, Ardeth S. Frizzell began employment at Station WBBY, Westerville, Ohio as business manager. In January 1991, she was promoted to general manager of WBBY, and served in that capacity until the station went off the air pursuant to FCC order on December 31, 1991.

At the present time, Ardeth S. Frizzell is business and traffic manager at Station WCKX, London, Ohio.
