**FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION

I am writing in opposition to the referenced
nprm. as submitted by the petitioner, A.R.R.L.

Specifically the usurption of 25% percent of the
14mhz, and 50% of the 21mhz spectrum
traditionally occupied by Baudot RTTY
operation. (14095 to 14100 and 21090 to 21100)
This has been done without, proper consideration
of the current users both in this country and
internationally. The modes anticipated in the
nprm are not compatible with weak signal RTTY.

It would appear that it would be much more
equitable to dedicate appropriate spectrum above
100 in each of the bands, where such a large
percentage reduction of current usage would not
occur.

My correspondence with D. Sumner of A.R.R.L
indicated a lack of concern for the existing
service and no intention of seeking a
compromise, therefore I must appeal to the
F.C.C. directly to consider the effects of the
NPRM on those of us who do weak signal RTTY on
an international basis in this spectrum. The
A.R.R.L proposal will negatively impact RTTY
operation world wide, and I think will certainly
be viewed by foreign amatuers as one more case
of "ugly American" arrogance.

Thank you for your consideration of my comments.
