
employee. In accordance with previously-made divestiture pledges, a new divestiture pledge is made with respect to this employment.

3. Good cause exists for acceptance of this amendment in that Section 1.65 of the Rules (47 C.F.R. §1.65) requires that all material information contained in the application be kept up to date. Although it is questionable whether Ms. Frizzell's employment by a broadcast station is material, the change is being reported nevertheless. Since there had previously been a divestiture commitment made by Ms. Frizzell, no comparative upgrading results from acceptance of this amendment.

4. Accordingly, it is respectfully requested that leave be granted to amend the application, and that the amendment attached hereto be accepted.
