ORDER

Issued: May 19, 1993; Released: May 20, 1993

This is a ruling on certain pleadings that were filed by Midamerica Electronics Service, Inc. ("Midamerica") that do not call for a response. Specifically, Midamerica has filed on May 17, 1993, a "Response To Document Production Order" and a "Request For Correction Of Address".

First, Midamerica will observe the same limits that were specified for the production of "financing documents" that were applied in earlier rulings: FCC 93M-231, FCC 93M-235, and FCC 93M-236 ("financing documents" under the standard document production do not include the documents enumerated for Form 301 certification). The rulings enumerated above are deemed to be sufficient for Midamerica to determine the scope of the documents which it must disclose under the standard request. However, Midamerica must also consider its obligations to make full and complete document production under the recently added financial issues and the related document production that has been ordered. See Memorandum Opinion and Order, FCC 93M-276, released May 18, 1993.

The accurate designation of counsel's address is essential to the timely receipt of procedural and discovery rulings which require strict compliance under the expedited procedures for new commercial FM comparative cases.
