I just wanted you to know how much I appreciate your excellent coverage of our Retinopathy Screenings and Alert Activities on Channel 43. The response from Brevard County was much greater than in the other three counties, and that is certainly due in part to the publicity that we received from Channel 43.

in Brevard, a total of 305 patients have been scheduled for retinopathy screenings. We have a total of 383 patients that were scheduled in the four counties. The publicity that we received in Brevard County was much better than in the other areas, and I believe that accounts for the lesser number of patients being scheduled in Orange, Osceola and Seminole counties. We were able to track quite a number of calls that we received due to the Channel 43 interviews.

The program has been an overwhelming success and has exceeded our wildest expectations. Thank you again for your continued support of the American Diabetes Association and for greatly enhancing our public and patient awareness programs.
