JOINT STATEMENT CONCERNING SETTLEMENT

KR Partners ("KR"), KES Communications, Inc. ("KES"), and Lori Lynne Forbes ("Forbes"), by their respective counsel, hereby provide the following report concerning the status of their settlement efforts, and request a two week extension of the suspension of all procedural dates to allow the parties to complete preparation of settlement papers for filing.

The parties previously submitted Joint Statements Concerning Settlement on June 14 and 17, 1993. By Order, FCC 93M-385, released June 21, 1993, the Presiding Judge suspended the procedural dates in this proceeding until July 8, 1993, so the parties could prepare settlement documents for filing.

During a joint telephone conference between counsel for the parties applicant and the Presiding Judge held this day, the parties advised the Presiding Judge of the progress towards completing the settlement documents. In particular, draft settlement agreements have been exchanged and are close to



completion. Because the settlement provides for the merger of KR and KES to form a new corporation, it is also necessary to prepare a shareholders agreement between the stockholders of this new corporation. The preparation of the shareholders agreement is requiring more time than the settlement agreements among the parties. This is due, in part, to the number of issues which the shareholders agreement must address, the fact that until approximately one month ago the principals of KR and KES had never met and had been adversaries in this proceeding, and the different locations and time zones where the principals reside which complicates communication among the principals and their counsel.

To provide the parties additional time to complete the preparation of the settlement documents the parties applicant request the Presiding Judge to extend the suspension of the procedural dates in this proceeding for an additional two weeks, until July 23, 1993. The parties anticipate filing the settlement agreements, along with the appropriate joint request for approval, by that date. Counsel for the Mass Media Bureau has been notified of the filing of this request.


