I've noticed you have changed from early Monday to early Tuesday to perform your maintenance (at least this is what I thought).

Now your blantant, obvious fraudulent false advertisements have me more upset than before. Viewers tune into channel 67 to watch the Home Shopping Club-becuse it's advertised to air 24 hours a day, due to it's great response. Well you have really done it, this simple ad is a miscarriage of truth, an out and out lie.

As I sat watching the Home Shopping Club and enjoying the program when at 6:30 a.m. on Sunday morning it was pre-empted by your station to air Vegetable Soup. Anyone in their right mind and watching Home Shopping Club certainly did not wish to view Vegetable Soup. This definitely is not a part of the Home Shopping Club. After Vegetable Soup I was subjected to The Miracle Program with Bob Tilton (who is this man). Then at 8:00 when I was sure the H.S.C. would be back on the air I changed the channel back to 67 to find Alan L. Jandl of Living Stones Church of Alvin, Texas. At 8:30 I still have Mr. Jandl. At 9:00 (just when I thought H.S.C. certainly would be back on and returned the dial to 67, only to find Metropolitan Methodist Church Services with Pastor Doud. It's now 9:30 and on channel 67, the channel that is supposed to air Home Shopping 24 hours, there still remains on the T.V. church services. It's now been 3 hours of programing which doesn't include your 24 hour advertised show, the H.S.C.. With every passing minute the more upset I become. After all, if I wished to watch programs other than Home Shopping, I have a variety of stations to choose from. I view channel 67 only for Home Shopping.

The F.C.C., from what I understand is quite strict as to false advertising and other illegal activities channel 67 insists on continuing even after complaints to the contrary. I'm fairly sure I'm not the only person to complain about your lack of respect for legal practices. It's now 10:00 a.m. and finally the scheduled program is back on the air.




