SUPPLEMENT TO JOINT PETITION FOR APPROVAL
OF SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

On June 18, 1993, Community Television of Southern California ("Community") and Valley Public Television, Inc. ("Valley") filed a "Joint Petition For Approval of Settlement Agreement" ("Joint Petition") requesting that the Settlement Agreement ("Agreement") attached thereto as Exhibit 1 be approved and that, upon approval, the above-referenced applications for a new noncommercial educational television station to operate on Channel *39, Bakersfield, California, be dismissed without prejudice. The purpose for this pleading is to submit the following two Amendments to the Agreement:

1. Attached hereto as Exhibit A is an "Amendment" to change the provision of the Agreement that the Community and Valley applications be dismissed without prejudice (Paragraph 2, page 2), to provide that the parties will dismiss their applications with prejudice.

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2. Attached hereto as Exhibit B is a "Clarifying Amendment" directed to the provision of the Agreement pursuant to which Community agreed "to do no direct mailing to residents of the Counties of Kings, Tulare and Fresno soliciting new members" (Paragraph 14, p. 6). The parties have clarified that provision so that it now applies to Community's direct mailings soliciting new members addressed to the zip codes set forth in Exhibit 1 to Exhibit B.

3. Finally, the Joint Petition requested, inter alia, that the applications of Valley and Community be dismissed without prejudice. This request is hereby amended to request dismissal with prejudice.
