By the Chief, Mass Media Bureau:

1. The Interim Report in PP Docket No. 93-21, FCC 93-333 (released July 1, 1993), is corrected to replace the seventh sentence of paragraph 44 and to replace Chart 8 of Appendix C. The seventh sentence of paragraph 44 is replaced by the following two sentences:

44. * * * On the local level, Chart 8 shows that the number of MLB games shown on local cable channels has increased more than fivefold from 1981 to 1992 -- from 215 games to 1,157 games. In contrast, the number of MLB games shown on broadcast television has increased by four percent over the same time period -- from 1,488 games broadcast locally in 1981 to 1,547 games broadcast locally in 1992.* * *
