ORDER

This is a ruling on a Supplemental Motion For Production of Documents filed by Martha J. Huber ("Huber") on July 7, 1993. A Response Of Rita Reyna Brent ("Brent") was filed on July 20, 1993.


- Request No. 1 Brent must produce all documents on which Brent will rely to prove that she is presently financially qualified. This request is otherwise denied.
- Request No. 2 Brent need not produce the documents sought under this request because there has already been a ruling on the scope of this discovery.
- Requests Nos. 3-8 There is no relevance to the documents sought by Huber regarding PPB, Inc. and those documents need not be produced.
- Request No. 9 Brent must produce all documents relied on in preparing the "reconstructed" balance sheet of Robert and Rita Brent dated November 13, 1991.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the documents ordered to be produced under Requests Nos. 1 and 9, as ruled on above, SHALL BE PRODUCED at the offices of Huber's counsel by 4 p.m. on July 27, 1993.<sup>1</sup>

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Supplemental Motion For Production Of Documents filed by Huber on July 7, 1993, IS DENIED as to Requests Nos. 2 through 8.
