Enclosed for filing with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) in triplicate is an application for transfer of control of The Petroleum V. Nasby Corporation (FCC Form 315), licensee of Station WSWR(FM), Shelby, OH. Also enclosed is the requisite filing fee payable to the FCC in the amount of \$565.00.

The transfer of shares herein by Thomas L. Root, Individually and as a Custodian for the benefit of his minor children, and Kathy G. Root, to Kathy G. Root, Individually and as Custodian for the benefit of her minor children, to Arlene M. Geer, as Trustee for the benefit of the minor children of Thomas L. and Kathy G. Root, and to Joanne L. and Thomas F. Root, Jointly, occurred in June, 1989. The ownership changes were reflected in the corporation's 1990 annual ownership report filed on April 27, 1990 by Timothy J. Moore, President of The Petroleum V. Nasby Corporation and General Manager of Station WSWR(FM) (copy of cover letter and report attached hereto as Appendix A).

In the course of preparing a submission to be presented to Commission staffpersons relative to the station's pending license renewal application (File No. BRH-890601VB), a review of the ownership information of the licensee by undersigned counsel reflected that while the individual transactions involved less than 50% of the stock of the licensee corporation's being transferred, cumulatively, the transactions result in more than 50% of the stock being transferred. With the exception of Arlene M. Geer, the Trustee for the benefit of Thomas L. and Kathy G. Root's minor children, qualifications of all other parties to the transfer application have previously been passed upon.

Accordingly, it is hereby requested that these cumulative stock transactions and the resultant transfer of control be granted nunc pro tunc. To the extent questions exist relative to the prior ownership of Thomas L. Root in the corporation, these matters will be addressed by the licensee in a separate submission to be filed shortly with the Commission relative to the station's license renewal. If requested, this presentation will be filed as supplementary information to this transfer application.

In accordance with the informal discussions undersigned counsel has had with a Commission staff person, a separate transfer of control application is being submitted on this date relative to the proposed transfer of 70.25 shares of stock in the licensee corporation from Joanne L. and Thomas F. Root, Jointly, to Ginsburg, Feldman & Bress, Chartered. The proposed transfer is contingent on the FCC's approval nunc pro tunc of the prior transfer of 70.25 shares of stock from Thomas L. Root to Joanne L. and Thomas F. Root, which forms a part of the transfer of control application referenced above. The proposed transfer of 70.25 shares independently does not result in the transfer of more than 50% of the stock of the licensee corporation, however, if combined with the prior transactions referenced herein, more than 50% of the stock of the licensee corporation is being transferred. In addition, the proposed long-form transfer will permit the FCC to "pass upon" the qualifications of Ginsburg, Feldman & Bress, Chartered.

As reflected in both transfer applications, Thomas L. Root is currently residing in a federal correctional institution, and undersigned counsel was advised informally by a Commission staff person, that in light of this situation, her signature would be acceptable in accordance with the Commission's signature requirements reflected at 47 C.F.R. § 73.3513(b). Undersigned counsel believes the information contained in the transfer application is true and correct to her best information and belief based on information obtained from the review of the corporation's records, from FCC records, from corporate counsel for the licensee corporation and from the President and General Manager of the corporation, and with respect to Exhibit III of the licensee's section of FCC Form 315, from corporate counsel of the licensee corporation and Thomas L. Root, directly.

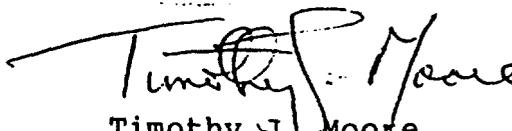

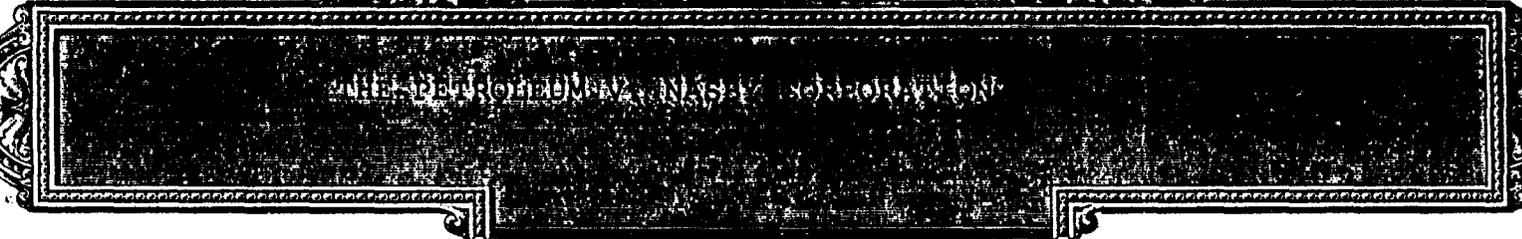

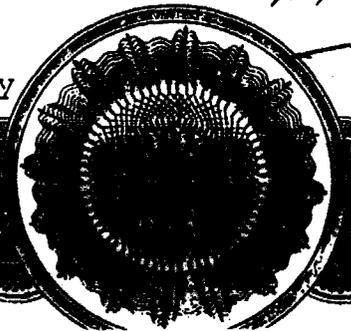


Exhibit B
