ORDER

Issued: August 6, 1993 ; Released: August 10, 1993

Under consideration are "Petition For Leave To Amend" filed July 22, 1993 by Glendale Broadcasting Company (Glendale), and Comments On Petition For Leave To Amend filed August 2, 1993 by Trinity Christian Center of Santa Ana, Inc., d/b/a Trinity Broadcasting Network (Trinity).

Glendale's amendment reports the specification of a character issue against Glendale in the Miami, Florida television proceeding (MM Docket No. 93-75). Glendale urges that there is no reason to designate the same issue against Glendale in this proceeding, suggesting instead that any grant of Glendale's application in this proceeding could be conditioned upon final action in the Miami proceeding.

The Presiding Judge agrees with Glendale and Trinity that there is no need for a separate hearing in this proceeding on the Glendale character issue. However, because an adverse resolution of that issue in the Miami proceeding could impair Glendale's basic qualifications in this proceeding, a condition will be specified on the grant of a construction permit awarded to Glendale.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, That the "Petition For Leave To Amend" filed July 22, 1993 by Glendale Broadcasting Company IS GRANTED and the amendment IS ACCEPTED subject to the following condition:


