I write to support the Comments of the Cable Act Preservation Alliance ("CAPA") and to disapprove of the proposals and tentative conclusions set forth in the FCC's September 25 Further Notice of Proposed Rule Making in Implementation of Section 621(a)(1) of the Cable Communications Policy Act of 1984 as Amended by the Cable Television Consumer Protection and Competition Act of 1992, MB Docket 05- 311.

I have been a volunteer at Chelmsford TeleMedia (CTM) for the past 2 ½ years. In that time I have seen first hand all of the good CTM does for our town (Chelmsford, MA). The wide range of programming provides an outlet for all who wish to be creative and produce, record and broadcast their own shows.

CTM also provides live broadcasts for community events such as: High School sports, the annual 4th of July Parade (The largest parade in eastern MA), Fall and Spring Town Meetings, Board of Selectmen meetings, School Committee meetings and a multitude of additional government boards and committees. All of these telecasts are also archived to provide a visual history of all events.

In addition to live broadcasts, I and a host of other volunteers are involved in recording presentations at the town library, senior center and schools for broadcast and archiving.

All of the above supports the existence of CTM and outlines its relevance and importance to our town. It is an integral part of the community. All of the broadcasts allow our senior citizens to stay abreast with community meetings and events as well as maintaining a visual history for Chelmsford.

I strongly urge you to reject this rule change. It will decimate a vital, valuable and irreplaceable resource for our town and citizens.
