This submission serves as an Appeal to waive program rules for a Last Date to Invoice extension that was issued 7/6/2017 on behalf of Woodbourne Schools, BEN 16068096, for the Verizon Wireless FRN 2846984 on Form 471 Application 1004117.

The Woodbourne School provides therapeutic educational services to boys residing in the Woodbourne Residential Treatment Center and to students from the community who need a more specialized and intensive school program in order to be successful. The school is a Level V, non-public school for youth in grades 6-12, and is accredited by the Maryland State Department of Education.

Woodbourne School offers a full schedule of classes and electives. For every three Woodbourne students, there is one school staff member. As a result, teachers know each boy very well and can design and carry out an Individual Education Plan (IEP).

Boys leave the Woodbourne School with a greater understanding of academic subjects, as well as art, athletics, and technology. Equally important, boys learn appropriate behaviors to ease their transition back into community schools.

We believe that all students are capable of academic achievement, regardless of their history, mental health diagnosis, and/or past school experiences. It is our job to provide a new educational experience that meets the students where they are and supports them to move toward their newly discovered potential as a lifelong learner. **The amount in our appeal may seem inconsequential, but please know that every dollar counts in helping these students learn.** Please approve the request.
