On November 30, 2017, Monica Gambino, and Robert Millar of Crown Castle along with the undersigned and Ari Meltzer of Wiley Rein LLP met with Commissioner Brendan Carr and his Legal Advisor, Kevin Holmes, to discuss issues raised in the above-referenced proceedings.

The Crown Castle representatives discussed the various barriers facing deployment of next generation broadband networks. In particular, they focused on issues relating to ensuring timely access to the right-of-way for broadband facilities, dealing with unreasonable fees, reforming historic and environmental review, and addressing legal issues such as the proper standard for prohibition and how to implement deemed grant procedures. Each of the positions advanced were consistent with Crown Castle's prior written comments in these proceedings.
