Under consideration is a Motion to Withdraw Settlement Agreement and to Set Procedural Schedule, filed August 12, 1993, by Raymond W. Clanton and Loren F. Selznick.

The parties in the above-captioned proceeding request the withdrawal of the Joint Petition for Approval of Settlement Agreement, filed April 21, 1993, and request that the Presiding Judge set a procedural schedule in this proceeding.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the Motion to Withdraw Settlement Agreement and to Set Procedural Schedule, filed August 12, 1993 IS GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following procedural dates are established:

- August 31, 1993 - Exchange all documents pursuant to Standard Document Production and exchange of Standard Integration Statements (SIS)
- September 7, 1993 - Deadline for supplemental requests for documents (if any)
- September 14, 1993 - Depositions of each party to commence at 10:00 a.m. in Washington, D.C.
- October 5, 1993 - Exchange of exhibits (to include the exchanged SIS and signed frozen sworn testimony)¹

¹ All exhibits will be assembled in a binder with each exhibit bearing a number with a tab on each document. An index containing a descriptive title of each exhibit shall be submitted. The exhibits will be serially numbered, starting with the number 1. A prefix will be used to indicate the party

- October 12, 1993 - Exchange notifications of witnesses requested for cross-examination stating reasons and legal precedent (service by hand to Administrative Law Judge)
- October 14, 1993 - Exchange of oppositions (if any) to witness requests
- October 19, 1993 - Commencement of hearing at 10:00 A.M. in a Commission courtroom in Washington, D.C.
