

WC DOCKET Number 18-155 regarding: Updating the
Inter-carrier Compensation Regime including conference

I, J. Paul and my wife Anna being of an older age use
and depend on free calling for church services and singing calls.
We also use it to stay in contact with family + friends.
We wish these privileges could continue. We won't
be able to afford conference calls if we must pay for them.

As a taxpayer, and a free conference calling client, I ask you to please consider
acting on WC Docket No. 18-155. My free conference calling services are currently at
risk of being completely eliminated and costing me, millions of others and our
businesses.

I am urging you to refrain from eliminating services that I and millions of other
Americans use regularly.

Long-distance carriers will not be negatively affected, financially or otherwise, if free
conference calling services are left alone. In fact, they stand to gain upwards of \$ 80
million.

However, if the FCC does decide to remove these services, I and millions of other
American citizens and American businesses will be immediately and negatively
affected. We will no longer be able to use these services for free and will instead be
forced to pay for conferencing services provided by the the long-distance carriers if we
want to reach our non-profit organizations, our families, our churches, singing calls,
news calls, prayer groups, supports groups, board meetings, committee meetings,
startups, schools, and global corporate communities meetings and their families.

Widows and other lonely individuals are finding comfort in this type of free
free conference calling.

Do not take away my free conference calling services and further line the pockets of
major long-distance carriers.

I ask the Federal Communication Commission to refrain from proceeding with its
rule making in WC Docket No. 18-155.
