

EXHIBIT I

ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT TO MAKE A CHARITABLE GIFT OF ASSETS

This is an AGREEMENT TO MAKE A CHARITABLE GIFT OF ASSETS made and entered into the _____ day of November, 1989, by and between FAMILY STATIONS, INC. ("Donor") and SOUTHWEST EDUCATIONAL MEDIAL FOUNDATION OF TEXAS, INC., (Donee"). Donor is the permittee of unbuilt station KBTT, Bridgeport, Texas (BPED-831115AK) (hereinafter referred to as "Station"). Donee is a non-profit corporation as defined in Section 501 (3) of the Internal Revenue and Donor desires to make a charitable gift to Donee of the Station permit according to the terms hereof and in furtherance of said gift to secure an assignment of Station's permit issued by the Federal Communications Commission (hereinafter referred to as "FCC" or "Commission").

In consideration of the mutual promises and covenants herein contained, the parties intending to be legally bound agree as follows:

1. Delivery of Assets. Donor agrees to make a charitable gift of the Station construction permit ("c.p."), including all right, title and interest in and to the call letters KBTT.

2. Transfer of Assets as a Charitable Gift. This entire transfer of property by Donor to Donee is made as a charitable gift within the contemplation of the applicable sections of the Internal Revenue Code.

3. Representations and Warranties of Donee. Donee represents and warrants to Donor that:

3.1 Organization and Standing. Donee is now and on the

closing date will be a non-profit corporation according to the definitions contained in the Internal Revenue Code Section 501 (c)(3) duly organized, validly existing and in good standing under the Laws of the State of Texas and has been issued a certificate from the Internal Revenue Code reflecting it is in a tax-exempt status and that all gifts to such corporation such as the transaction contemplated by this agreement are tax-deductible.

3.2 Authorization. All necessary corporate action to duly accept the gift set forth in this contract and the consummation of the transaction contemplated hereby has been taken by Donee and this agreement constitutes a valid and binding agreement by Donee.

3.3 Qualification of Donee. Donee is legally and financially qualified to accept the Station as a gift and assume the obligations as part of said gift as set forth in this contract and to be the assignee of the FCC permit under the Communications Act of 1934 as amended and the rules and policies of the FCC. Donee is not engaged in any proceedings which would prevent the assignment of the FCC permit hereunder nor is it aware of any claim which would result in such a proceeding or which would prevent the sale contemplated herein:

3.4 Litigation. There is no litigation or claim of any nature whatsoever pending or threatened against Donee, that Donee has not disclosed to Donor which could affect the transaction contemplated by this agreement of gift or Donee or Donor in the exercise of this gift.

4. Closing. Closing will take place within five (5) business days

following Commission approval of the assignment of permit hereunder.

5. Time for Commission Consent. In the event that the grant of the assignment application by the FCC has not become a final order within six (6) months of the assignment application being tendered for filing with the FCC, either Donor or Donee may thereafter terminate this agreement of gift upon five (5) days written notice to the other party.

6. Acceptance of Gift. Donee, by execution of this agreement of gift through its duly authorized officer accepts the gift contemplated hereby.

7. Notice. All notices, demand and requests required or permitted to be given under the provisions of this agreement shall be deemed duly given if sent by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, addressed as follows:
