I would like to bring to your attention the concerns raised by roughly 1000 of my constituents regarding a forbearance petition filed with the FCC by USTelecom (WC Docket No. 18-141). The petition would impact provisions of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 that enable competition for telecommunications and broadband services. The letters that my constituents submitted to the FCC regarding the petition illustrate the importance of alternative competitive providers in the telecommunications marketplace. These competitive providers leverage existing infrastructure and invest in local markets, which in turn ensures that communities like those in my district have choices when it comes to telecommunications and broadband.
