On December 6, 2017, the undersigned, along with Tonya Rideout, NATOA's incoming Executive Director, and NATOA Board of Directors members Mike Lynch, Mike Johnson, Michael Russo, Jodie Miller, Brian Roberts, Daniel Cohen, Gabriel Garcia, and Ann Goldenberg, met with Commissioner Mignon Clyburn and her Wireline Legal Advisor Claude Aiken to discuss the above-referenced proceedings.

During the meeting, we discussed a number of issues of concern to local governments that have been raised through comments filed to date in these proceedings, including the potential impact of any FCC action on recently enacted state small wireless facilities siting legislation, public safety concerns surrounding deployments in the public rights-of-way, and the need for an updated RF study on small cell deployments. We also discussed the continuing need for Lifeline services and the need for effective partnerships to ensure affordable connectivity for all residents.
