On December 5, 2017, I spoke via telephone to Jamie Susskind, Chief of Staff to Commissioner Brendan Carr. On December 6, 2017, Scott Harris of this firm made a telephone call to Jay Schwarz, Wireline Advisor to Chairman Ajit Pai. On that same day, I spoke via telephone to Amy Bender, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Michael O’Rielly, and separately via telephone with Madeleine Findley, Deputy Bureau Chief of the Wireline Competition Bureau. In each of these calls, on behalf of Akamai Technologies, Inc., we discussed the need for express language to clarify the distinction between Content Delivery Network services and paid prioritization, as proposed in Akamai’s November 30, 2017 ex parte.¹
