JOINT MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEDURAL DATES

KR Partners ("KR"), KES Communications, Inc. ("KES"), and Lori Lynne Forbes ("Forbes"), by their respective counsel, hereby request the Presiding Judge to suspend all procedural dates in this proceeding in light of the settlement which the parties have reached. In support thereof the following is stated.

The parties are concurrently filing a Joint Request for Approval of Agreements which requests the Presiding Judge to approve a Merger Agreement between KES and KR, and to approve a Settlement Agreement among KES, KR and Forbes. Together, these agreements provide for the merger of KES and KR into a single applicant (Hawaii Broadcasting Company, Inc.), the dismissal of Forbes' application in consideration for reimbursement of Forbes' legitimate and prudent expenses in filing and prosecuting her application up to \$32,500, and a grant of the amended Hawaii Broadcasting Company application. A grant of the Joint Request and approval of the settlement agreements will resolve this proceeding


without the need for a comparative hearing.

On July 28, 1993, the Presiding Judge released an Order, FCC 93M-494, in which he set forth revised procedural dates in the event the parties did not file settlement papers by August 11, 1993. While the parties were not able to complete final preparation and filing of the settlement documents by August 11, they are filing the Joint Request and related documents prior to any of the revised procedural dates set forth in the Order. Because the parties have now completed the settlement agreements and submitted them to the Presiding Judge for his consideration, continuing with the hearing phase of this proceeding would disserve the public interest by requiring the expenditure of considerable time and economic resources of the Commission and the parties. A suspension of the procedural dates is, therefore, appropriate, to allow the Mass Media Bureau time to submit comments on the settlement (if it decides to do so) and to permit the Presiding Judge to consider the settlement.

Wherefore, for the foregoing reasons, the parties respectfully request the Presiding Judge to grant this Motion and to suspend the procedural dates in this proceeding.


