On December 6, 2017, the undersigned, along with Tonya Rideout, NATOA's incoming Executive Director, and NATOA Board of Directors members Mike Lynch, Jodie Miller, Brian Roberts, Daniel Cohen, Gabriel Garcia, Mike Johnson, Michael Russo, and Ann Goldenberg, met with Commissioner Jessica Rosenworcel and her Chief of Staff Travis Litman and Wireless Legal Advisor Umair Javed to discuss the above-referenced proceedings.

During the meeting, we discussed a number of issues of concern to local governments that have been raised through comments filed to date in these proceedings, including the potential impact of any FCC action on recently enacted state small wireless facilities siting legislation, the need for an updated RF study on small cell deployments, and the need for full deployment of advanced services to all parts of a community. We also discussed the continuing need for Lifeline services and efforts to address the homework gap.
