On December 5, 2017, Dan Hackett of ShawnTech Communications, Inc. met with the following individuals with the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau: Charles Mathias, Lloyd Coward, Anna Gentry, Melissa Conway, Mary Claire York.

ShawnTech Communications, Inc. provided an update on the current activities with the ShawnTech C5 Managed Access Solution. The update included a description of the status of an ongoing project with the Indiana Department of Corrections as well as discussion of other states contemplating similar systems. Discussion ensued regarding ShawnTech's services to assist correctional agencies identify to identify and manage contraband wireless device as well as insight into best practices associated with this service.
