Dear FCC,

As a producer of free content that educates and inspires the Oahu audience to be better leaders and project managers, I strongly protest the FCC 05-311.

The FCC is economically inhibiting the ability for non-profits to develop and deliver community content. My direct audience is afforded a free means to learn about what it means to be a professional project manager and maintain their certification...or seek ways to get certified. I volunteer for my non-profit so levying an expense on Olelo and likelihood to my organization (passing the costs) essentially shuts the program. This is wrong. You are impacting my ability to give voice to the community and my audience.

We need to investigate why profitable companies cannot afford giving free access and why this policy of free access is reversed. The FCC is reversing its freedom of speech in my opinion but squelching access economically. Please veto/close/terminate FCC 05-311.
