## **RE: FCC Tentative conclusions in the Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking outlined in MB Docket No. 05-311 - OPPOSE**

Dear Chairman Pai and honorable Commissioners,

The County of Kern joins the National Association of Counties (NACO) and the California State Association of Counties (CSAC) to express our disagreement with the tentative conclusions in the Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (FNPRM) outlined in MB Docket No. 05-311.

Specifically, the FNPRM will have significant impacts on local governments that undermine the express goals of the Cable Act. The proposed reduction in franchise fees of the fair market value of nearly every cable-related franchise obligation will be felt by local governments of all sizes throughout the country. The potentially significant reductions in franchise fees contemplated in the FNPRM would drastically reduce, and in some cases eliminate, the rent Congress intended local franchising authorities (LFAs) to receive.

Here in Kern County, those losses could add up to roughly \$680,000 per year in unrealized General Fund discretionary dollars that provide a myriad of goods and services to our citizens.

For these reasons, Kern County respectfully urges that the Commission refrain from enacting the tentative conclusions and rules as stated in the FNPRM. There is no basis in the Cable Act to change the long, and widely-held, understanding that cable operators must meet the cable-related community needs and interests in addition to paying a five percent franchise fee for the use of local rights of way.
