What is in this letter?

Thank you for submitting your post-commitment request for **Funding Year 2018 Schools and Libraries Program (E-rate) funding**. Attached to this letter, you will find the revised funding statuses and/or post commitment changes to the original Funding Commitment Decision Letter (FCDL) you received. Below are the changes that were made:

The Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) is providing this information to both the applicant(s) and the service provider(s) so that all parties are aware of the post-commitment changes related to their funding requests and can work together to complete the funding process for these requests.

Next Steps

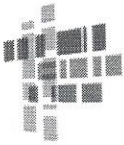

Obligation to Pay Non-Discount Portion

Applicants are required to pay the non-discount portion of the cost of the eligible products and/or services to their service providers. Service providers are required to bill applicants for the non-discount portion of costs for the eligible products and/or services. The FCC stated that requiring applicants to pay the non-discounted share of costs ensures efficiency and accountability in the program. If using the BEAR invoicing method, the applicant must pay the service provider in full (the non-discount plus discount portion) **before** seeking reimbursement from USAC. If using the SPI invoicing method, the service provider must first bill the applicant **before** invoicing USAC.

Notice on Rules and Funds Availability

The applicants' receipt of funding commitments is contingent on their compliance with all statutory, regulatory, and procedural requirements of the Schools and Libraries Program and the FCC's rules. Applicants who have received funding commitments continue to be subject to audits and other reviews that USAC and/or the FCC may undertake periodically to assure that funds that have been committed are being used in accordance with such requirements. USAC may be required to reduce or cancel funding commitments that were not issued in accordance with such requirements, whether due to action or inaction, including but not limited to that by USAC, the applicant, or the service provider. 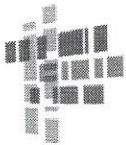

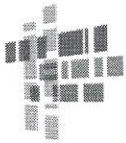

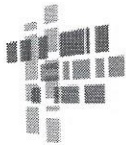
Post Commitment Rationale:

Your appeal has been partially approved. We approved your request to change the service start date from 7-1-2018 to 10-1-2018. The amount of the funding request was changed from \$83,649.60 to \$62,737.20 to reflect the correct number of months of service. Conversely, Your request to add two new funding requests with Opteman and Gigaman for the service period of 7-1-18 thru 9-30-18 has been denied. During appeal review of your FCC 471 Application Number 181011104 you requested that two new funding request be added to your application. Program procedures allow applicants to amend their applications and correct ministerial and clerical errors on their FCC Forms (including adding a funding request) until an Funding Commitment Decision Letter (FCDL) is issued. New



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funding requests cannot be submitted through the appeals process and after the issuance of the FCDL. Your appeal requests additional funds that were not included in the FCC Form 471 that you are appealing. FCC rules require that funding requests must be submitted via an FCC Form 471. See 47 C.F.R. sec. 54.504(a). Considerations for funding requests depend on the date the FCC Form 471 is received and the amount of funds available if it is received after the close of the filing window. See 47 C.F.R. sec. 54.507(f). 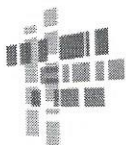

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Post Commitment Rationale:

Your appeal has been partially approved. We approved your request to change the service start date from 7-1-2018 to 10-1-2018. The amount of the funding request was changed from \$15,162.48 to \$11,371.86 to reflect the correct number of months of service. Conversely, Your request to add two new funding requests with Opteman and Gigaman for the service period of 7-1-18 thru 9-30-18 has been denied. During appeal review of your FCC 471 Application Number 181011104 you requested that two new funding request be added to your application. Program procedures allow applicants to amend their applications and correct ministerial and clerical errors on their FCC Forms (including adding a funding request) until an Funding Commitment Decision Letter (FCDL) is issued. Appeal for FRN 1899017904 & 1899042290 on Application 181011104

10/19/18

Regarding FRN's 1899017904 and 1899042290, we are unequivocally refuting and appealing the RFCDL that was issued for Carlsbad Unified School District on September 6, 2018. This decision was totally unjust and did not portray the E-rate program as it is meant to be.

We had filed for **new** ATT Services (ASE and ADE circuits) on our 471 181011104 for 7/1/18-6/30/19. We received the FCDL on **5/26/18**. Two months later, we received an email from Ron Koning, ATT Project Manager, that the new services would not install by 7/1/18 nor could they state an exact date for installation but it would be by or after 9/30/18. They still have not installed.

We filed an appeal on 7/25/18 (#116953) to add two new FRN's for the dates of 7/1/-9/30/18 for the current services (OPTEMAN and GIGAMAN) and shorten the current FRN's to 10/1/18-6.30/19. The current and future services are for the same design: the District's WAN and connection to their ISP. OPTEMAN is being replaced by ASE and GIGAMAN is being replaced by ADE. We requested additional monthly funding in our appeal because the current services (OPTEMAN and GIGAMAN) are substantially more than the new services (ASE and ADE). \$12,254.45 for OPTEMAN vs \$6970.80 we requested for ASE and \$2202.51 for the GIGAMAN vs \$1263.54 for ADE. The District is already losing a lot of funding since ATT wasn't able to fulfill their service installation date of 7/1/18. All services are all being provided by ATT. The RFCDL denied additional funding BUT ALSO denied the new FRN's **AND** removed the first three months of funding on the original FRN's!

The description of the denial suggests that we cannot amend our 471 applications after they have been approved. I've been working with Erate since 1998 and since 2002 as an Erate Consultant and, in the past, I have written appeals several times to USAC after the FCDL was issued, amending FRN's and won funding, where it was due.

The first three months of funding should be re-instated. If we can't have more funding to cover costs, we should still be allowed 3 months of funding at the rates requested and approved on the FCDL. The District should not be without funding for 3 months when they clearly have followed all of the procurement rules and E-rate procedures. The District should not be penalized for the vendor failing to install services on time.

The primary objective of USAC is to ensure the schools benefit from the Erate program and denying funding is totally unacceptable. I understand if USAC does not want to give us additional funding over the original request (even though the current services are considerably more) but to **deny funding for those first three months, for existing services, is unconscionable.**

There is no evidence of waste, fraud, abuse or misuse of funds or a failure to adhere to the core program requirements. It would be a disservice and inflict undue hardship to remove \$12,351.51 (post discount) of funding for the Carlsbad Unified School District when they are, obviously, using these services (OPTEMAN and GIGAMAN) until the new services are installed. We have demonstrated that we have complied with all of USAC's application procedures for these services and the District should not be penalized for the inability of a vendor to install services on time.

Please reinstate \$20,912.40 pre-discount for FRN 1899017904 (\$6970.80 x 3 months) and \$3,790.62 for FRN 1899042290 (\$1263.54 x 3 months) and change the service dates back to 7/1/18-6/30/19. The total, pre-discount, for FRN 1899017904 should be \$83,649.60 and the total for FRN 1899042290 should be \$15,162.48 for the year, which was approved on the FCDL.

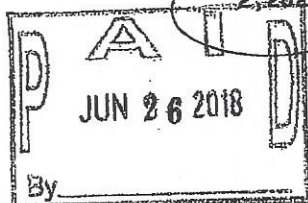

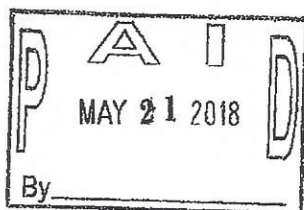

Case Description

Description We filed an appeal (Case #126847) on 10/19/18. We feel that the Applicant Erate Training that was just attended on Friday addresses our concern. On Slide 31, Transitioning Services from the Advanced Program Compliance section, presented by Bernie Manns, it shows: Applicants that are moving from one recurring service to another may have multiple locations which will transfer over time. The new service usually requires an installation schedule by site. Program rules prohibit the funding of duplicate service – same service to the same locations at the same time. Therefore, you will have to pick a cutover date(s) for each of the entities. You can apply for services from incumbent and new provider but USAC can only commit E-rate funds for 12 months of recurring service combined. If you don't know when you will cut over, you should estimate and work with USAC AFTER COMMITMENT TO CHANGE THE SERVICES AND/OR SPIN. We will split the FRNs if there are multiple SPINS involved.

During the presentation, Bernie Manns stated "USAC will work with the applicant after the FCDL". We need for USAC to work with us, giving us 12 months of service, not 9 months, even if the amount is not enough to cover the more expensive fees of the old service. However, the RFCDL REDUCED OUR REQUEST BY 3 MONTHS. This is a clear case where USAC incorrectly removed our funding for 3 months and we have Erate Training and Bernie Manns who should support our plea to reinstate those months so we have 12 months of service requested and granted.
