On December 13, 2018, the following representatives from Zebra Technologies Corporation and its affiliate, Zebra Technologies International, LLC, (together "Zebra") met with staff from the FCC's Wireless Office of Engineering and Technology (OET) to discuss the above-referenced proceeding. Representatives from Zebra included Carl Mower, Edward Richley and Veronica O'Connell (TwinLogic Strategies, consultant to Zebra). Representatives from OET included Julius Knapp, Jamison Prime, Michael Ha, Ira Keltz and Karen Rackley.

During the meeting, Zebra provided a power point presentation (attached to this letter) describing Zebra's Dart System, impact of the proposals outlined in the NPRM on the Dart System, and possible mitigation solutions that would continue to allow for unlicensed UWB technologies to successfully coexist with incumbent users and expanded unlicensed Wi-Fi uses in the 6 GHz band.
