We would like to appeal the decision by USAC to deny funding for FRNs 2678130, 2678138 and 2678176 of form 471 # 982284, FRNs 2678320, 2678301 and 2678298 of form 471 # 982446, FRNs 2679670, 2679675 and 2679679 of form 471 # 982975, FRNs 2679563 and 2679592 of form 471 # 982926, FRN 2679336 of form 471 # 982802 and FRN 2679211 of form 471 # 982756, FRN 2679261 of form 471 # 982784.

On the FCDL dated December 5/26/2017 it states: *This FRN is denied because the funding request appears to be duplicative of a current year's FRN. Program rules prohibit USAC from funding the same products and services, to the same location in the same funding year. The applicant failed to respond to the Administrator's Information Request to address the issue. As such, the FRN is denied.*

We are appealing this decision because we responded to all reviews that we got from USAC including a review we received from Fabio Nieto about the potential of duplicative funding requests. In our response we clearly showed there are no duplicates in our request as no location is receiving products and services twice. FRNs 2679336 and 2679211 that are both cellular service but are not duplicates, as all phones was used by different users.

We originally appealed directly to USAC however USAC denied our appeal. On the "Administrator's Decision on Appeal" letter dated December 7, 2017 it states "Upon review of the appeal and all relevant documentation, it has been determined that during the Program Integrity Assurance review process, Bais Ruchel D'Satmar (the District) failed to respond to the Administrator's Information Request dated June 9, 2016 to determine the eligibility of the above listed funding requests. The District was instructed that the request was time sensitive and that a response was expected within fifteen calendar days. As the District failed to respond, the funding requests were denied. In your appeal, you did not demonstrate or provide any evidence that USAC's decision was incorrect. Consequently, your appeal is denied."

**We are appealing this decision to the FCC, because on the original FCDL it stated *"This FRN is denied because the funding request appears to be duplicative of a current year's FRN. Program rules prohibit USAC from funding the same products and services, to the same location in the same funding year. The applicant failed to respond to the Administrator's Information Request to address the issue"* , this issue we clearly addressed in our appeal letter to USAC. As we copied the spreadsheet (that pertains to the FRNs of funding year 2014) that we had sent during the reviews of our applications, that spreadsheet clearly showed that our requests were not duplicates. After we sent our appeal to USAC, we did not receive any further requests from USAC. As far as the reason that USAC provided on the Administrator's Decision on Appeal" letter, that we failed to respond to a Program Integrity Assurance review, we believe that we responded to all USAC's inquiries and we addressed the issue USAC brought up during the review of the potential of duplicate services requested.**

**We are therefore hopeful that the FCC can overturn the USAC denial and provide us with the opportunity to respond to any issues USAC may have on our original applications.**

We would like to appeal the decision by USAC to deny funding for FRNs 2678130, 2678138 and 2678176 of form 471 # 982284, FRNs 2678320, 2678301 and 2678298 of form 471 # 982446, FRNs 2679670, 2679675 and 2679679 of form 471 # 982975, FRNs 2679563 and 2679592 of form 471 # 982926, FRN 2679336 of form 471 # 982802 and FRN 2679211 of form 471 # 982756.

On the FCDL dated December 5/26/2017 it states: *This FRN is denied because the funding request appears to be duplicative of a current year's FRN. Program rules prohibit USAC from funding the same products and services, to the same location in the same funding year. The applicant failed to respond to the Administrator's Information Request to address the issue. As such, the FRN is denied.*



We are appealing this decision because we responded to all reviews that we got from USAC including a review we received from Fabio Nieto about the potential of duplicative funding requests. In our response we clearly showed there are no duplicates in our request as no location is receiving products and services twice. FRNs 2679336 and 2679211 that are both cellular service but are not duplicates, as all phones was used by different users.
