PETITION FOR LEAVE TO AMEND AND AMENDMENT

Sample Broadcasting Company, L.P., ("Sample"), by its attorney hereby petitions for leave to amend its above-referenced application. This amendment is filed pursuant to Sections 73.3522 and 1.65 of the Commission's rules to update the broadcast interests of Bruce H. Linder, Sample's non-attributable principal, and his immediate family. It also reports a change in employment status for Carmela Sample-Day. In support thereof the following is shown.

This amendment is minor and technical in nature and is provided in order to keep the application true and correct pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Commission's rules. It reports that John Linder filed an application for consent to the assignment of his construction permit for station KRNQ Hampton, Iowa. Upon grant and consummation of the assignment of license, John Linder will have no further connection with

station KRNQ. An application has been filed for consent to the assignment of license of FM station KXAC St. James, Minnesota. Upon grant and consummation of the assignment of license, Bruce Linder will have no further connection with station KXAC. An application has been filed for consent to the transfer of control of the construction permit of FM station KARP Glencoe, Minnesota, to Minnesota Valley Broadcasting Company. Upon grant and consummation of the transfer of control, Minnesota Valley Broadcasting Company will become the 80% voting shareholder and John Linder will become the 20% voting shareholder of the permittee.

In addition, on August 19, 1993, Carmela Sample-Day was laid off from her employment with FM station KKSI Eddyville, Iowa, as the result of the downsizing of station staff and elimination of the full-time News Department. Sample-Day has no full-time employment at present, however, in the attached amendment she certifies that prior to commencing program test operations at the Eldon station, she will divest any employment she may acquire in order to devote her full time to managing and operating the station.

In order for Sample's amendment to be accepted, it must show good cause. Erwin O'Connor, 22 FCC 2d 140 (Rev. Bd. 1970), requires that the amendment (1) was prepared with diligence; (2) was not required by the voluntary act of the applicant; (3) will not necessitate modification or addition of issues or parties; (4) will not disrupt the orderly conduct

of the hearing or necessitate additional hearing; (5) will not unfairly prejudice other parties; and, (6) will not cause the applicant to gain a comparative advantage.

Sample's amendment meets each of the O'Connor requirements. The changes are reported within the thirty day period set forth under the rules.<sup>1</sup> This amendment, therefore, is timely. The changes were not caused by any voluntary act of Sample or Ms. Sample-Day. Inasmuch as Bruce Linder is a passive equity investor in Sample, his and his family's broadcast interests are of no significance to this comparative proceeding and will not necessitate modification or addition of issues or parties, nor will it disrupt this proceeding. Sample-Day pledged to divest her employment at KKSI in Sample's construction permit application; therefore, the termination of that position is of no significance to this comparative proceeding and will not necessitate modification or addition of issues or parties, nor will it disrupt this proceeding. This amendment is for reporting purposes only, will not unfairly prejudice any other party to this proceeding and will not affect Sample's comparative stature before the Commission.




