

Lynn Ketelsen hereby amends his above-identified application for authority to construct a new FM broadcast station at Blooming Prairie, Minnesota so as to report the following:

On January 25, 1993, the FCC issued an order in which Ketelsen's application for a new FM broadcast station at Sleepy Eye, Minnesota (File No. BPH-911003MD) was dismissed pursuant to a settlement agreement between Ketelsen and a mutually exclusive applicant, Brown County Broadcasting, Inc. (File No. BPH-911003MC). Brown County's application was granted in the same order. Pursuant to the settlement agreement, Brown County is to convey to Ketelsen capital stock equal to a 10% interest in Brown County.

Ketelsen hereby pledges that he will divest himself of all interest in and connection to Brown County's station at Sleepy Eye if his Blooming Prairie application is granted. This divestiture will occur before the Blooming Prairie station begins operating with program test authority.
