AMERITECH REFUND PLAN

1. Determine the credit due each LIDB customer by:

a. Reviewing the reports to obtain query volume for each customer.

b. Multiplying the number of queries for each customer by the difference between the rate charged and the revised rate. Pursuant to footnote 28 of the Commission's Order, Ameritech is to include an explanation of the computation of the refund amount accruing after July 1, 1993. The LIDB query rate was not changed July 1, 1993, so no change in procedures is required for this time period.

c. Adding simple interest, as computed on the basis of interest rates specified by the United States Internal Revenue Service, to the amount of the credit.

2. Issue a credit to the customer on their monthly bill within 60 days after approval of this plan.
