
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of CMCG Puerto Rico, LLC ("CMCGPR"), licensee of television stations WOST, Mayaguez and WQQZ-CD, Ponce, both in Puerto Rico, we hereby seek to add stations WOST and WQQZ-CD to the list of television stations seeking pre-Phase 1 transitions to post-auction channel assignments, as set forth in the November 14, 2017 letter filed on behalf of the coalition of television stations ("Requesting Stations") in Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands requesting the Commission to revise their Post-Auction Broadcast Transition phase assignments and deadlines.

CMCGPR's stations in Puerto Rico similarly experienced damage from Hurricanes Irma and Maria, and as of this date are still off-air. While it may be possible for CMCGPR to restore some degree of service over WOST and/or WQQZ-CD on their current channels once the extent of damage has been assessed and electric power restored, CMCGPR agrees with the Requesting Stations that full restoration of service would best be made on the reassignment channels.

CMCGPR also joins the Requesting Stations in urging that the Media Bureau allow liberal extensions of time and/or STAs to ensure continuation of service where conditions beyond its control precludes strict adherence to a new transition schedule.
