Under consideration are Petition for Leave to Amend, filed September 7, 1993, by Raymond W. Clanton ("Clanton"), and an Opposition to Clanton's Petition for Leave to Amend, filed September 16, 1993, by Loren Selznick ("Selznick").

Clanton wants to amend his application to state that up to \$86,000 of the funds needed for the construction and operation of his proposed station may come from his wife who has agreed to liquidate her shares in the Franklin U.S. Government Securities Fund ("Franklin Fund"). The application reflected that all funds were coming from him. He believed that the Franklin Fund was his even though it was registered in his wife's name alone. Although Clanton states that his wife has given him written assurance of the use of the money from the Franklin Fund, he has failed to furnish such assurance. Action on the Petition WILL BE HELD IN ABEYANCE, pending receipt of this written assurance.
