PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Haddonfield NJ 5ESS switch are associated with CLI code HDFDNJHDDS5 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.
- All references to the Camden NJ CS2K switch are associated with CLI code CMDNNJCEPS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Haddonfield 5ESS switch located at 35 S. Haddon Avenue, Haddonfield, NJ 08033, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Camden CS2K switch located at 12 N. 7th Street, Camden, NJ 08104. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), wireless, and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers, will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Camden CS2K switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that have direct end office trunking (DEOT) with access connectivity in the Haddonfield switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Camden CS2K switch.

All ASRs for the Camden CS2K switch must be received no later than July 21, 2018 in order to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. These DEOT interconnections will support traffic migration for the Haddonfield 5ESS switch, prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Haddonfield 5ESS switch (**on or after August 11, 2018**). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the fourteen (14) native codes currently served by the Haddonfield 5ESS switch to reflect the Camden CS2K switch as the new home switch. All ASRs for the Camden CS2K switch must carry the project code of **HDFDNJHDRP0**.
