
On December 20, 2018, James Troup and Tony Lee of Fletcher, Heald & Hildreth, Frank Hilton, Pat Vaughn, and Peter Keene of Iowa Network Services, Inc. d/b/a Aureon Network Services (“Aureon”), and Brian Sullivan and Paul Nesenson of JSI, Inc., held a conference call with FCC staff to discuss the FCC’s investigation of Aureon’s tariff rate. The following Commission staff members from the Wireline Competition Bureau were on the call: Victoria Goldberg, Edward Krachmer, Richard Kwiatkowski, and Chris Koves.

The purpose of the meeting was to answer FCC staff questions regarding circuit and cost information Aureon submitted in the FCC’s tariff investigation proceeding.
