Ownership Structure

Mr. Tyner is an individual applicant.

Integration

Should he be granted the new Construction Permit for Mansfield, Louisiana, Tyner will be partially integrated into the management activities of the proposed station.

He will devote part-time, at least 20 hours a week to the proposed station as General Manager. In this capacity, he will be responsible for all duties commonly associated with that position, including, but not limited to: overall supervision of construction of the station, overall supervision of station operations, news, programming, sales and public affairs. He will hire and fire all station personnel and will establish and implement all station policies.

Mr. Tyner is currently a partner in a law firm in Jackson Mississippi. Prior to the submission of the application for a construction permit, Mr. Tyner opened two branch law offices in South Louisiana. Mr. Tyner then successfully sat for the Louisiana Bar exam, and has since been admitted to practice law in that state. Mr. Tyner is a single male, and will be able to devote at least twenty hours a week to the Mansfield station. His firm has encouraged growth in Louisiana, and Mr. Tyner will open a branch law office in Shreveport

where he will maintain a second residence so as to be available to run the Radio Station. Mr. Tyner has been looking to acquire a radio station for several years and has spent a considerable amount of time and money in research and development, prior to making application for this Construction Permit, searching for the appropriate market for same. He is completely devoted to making this radio station a success, reaping the benefits of his patience and thorough research by providing local quality programming of which he and the community can be proud. Mr. Tyner looks forward to becoming an integral part of the community in Mansfield.

Since Mr. Tyner is now a partner of the law firm, and his firm has hired several associates over the past year, and continues to add associates, he now has additional time away from his litigation practice to devote to the radio station. Mr. Tyner's law firm represents victims exposed to chemicals. His role has increasingly become administrative and marketing for the firm rather than the actual litigation, which allows him the extra time to devote to the radio station. In opening a branch office in Shreveport, Mr. Tyner will easily be able to spend two days a week at the Mansfield station.

Qualitative Enhancements

Mr. Tyner will not claim credit under any of the Commission's enhancement categories, with the exception of proposed future residence in Mansfield, LA.
