Dear FCC:

We are an ISP / WISP in North Western Lower Peninsula of Michigan and have been in business providing Internet Service to this area for more than 21 years. Our company was formed back in 1996 due to the lack of internet service in this area.

Since the CBRS rules came into effect in 2015, we have made huge investments into LTE products using the 3650-3700Mhz band. With the new LTE gear under the CBRS band, we are very excited about the potential in servicing new customers that until recently had no good options for service. This band and the equipment using it has helped us open new service areas with service speeds of more than 30Mbps.

We strongly oppose the proposed rule changes to increase the size of the PALs or lengthen the terms of licenses. The proposed changes will severely limit our ability to participate in any auction. The proposed changes will in turn limit our growth into under-served and non-served areas. We fully support the support WISPA and Baicells Comments to deny the petitions to amend PAL area size and term lengths.

We have already invested heavily in the CBRS band and will invest more in the CBRS band, but only if the CBRS rules make sense for us to do so.
