As a rural Internet service provider we're constantly struggling to make ends meet. We're covering areas that do not have any service at all. Some of our towers cover 20+ square miles and only include a dozen homes.

Changing the CBRS census tracts to PEA is completely counter productive for serving the last mile. The big companies don't care about small areas like these. The only people that bother serve these areas have a vested interest; it is home. One town in particular locally would require three PEA licenses. This is a town of 400 people, 100 homes. What is the point of that other than to push the smaller service providers out so that only the big boys can play?
