In response to GN Docket No. 90-314, NPRM adopted Sept. 93, 1993, please accept these comments. They address the FCC's proposals to meet the 1993 Budget Reconciliation Act requirement that minority, women and small business entities be given the opportunity to participate in the PCS license competitive bidding process.

The measures proposed by the FCC in the above NPRM for the benefit of these designated groups will definitely go a long way towards supporting their efforts to compete and succeed in the wireless telecommunications industry. In particular, these measures will be of vital assistance to minority professionals and businesspersons as we continue to strive to overcome the societal, financial and other institutional barriers that have hindered us from achieving a "natural" presence in this industry.
