Dear Commissioners:

In response to your request for public comments, I would like to urge the Federal Communications Commission to proceed under its original lottery application guidelines for domestic public cellular telecommunications service as soon as possible.

Acting upon the FCC's invitation to participate, in April, 1993, I submitted applications for the unserved areas lottery with the intention of constructing and operating a cellular system. I chose to participate in the fill-in lottery because I have the financial resources and cellular telephone business background necessary to obtain the financing to successfully own and operate a cellular system if awarded through the originally announced lottery.

As a partner in a partnership which was awarded two RSA cellular service areas in a previously held FCC lottery, I have personal experience in the business of providing cellular telephone service to thousands of cellular telephone customers. Our partnership was awarded cellular licenses in Aberdeen, SD and Monroe, LA., where we currently own and operate cellular systems. As a corporate officer in both telephone systems, I remain actively engaged in the operations of these systems.

To assure fairness and public access to cellular telephone service opportunities, it is critical that the FCC expeditiously proceed under the originally announced cellular lottery guidelines. I would be pleased to discuss this matter, should any member of the FCC wish to discuss my qualifications further.
