STATEMENT OF BOB O'CONNOR

I have been a member of the Pittsburgh City Council since January 8 of 1992. Prior to my election to the City Council, I was the Vice President of Pappan's Enterprises, which owns and operates Roy Rogers Restaurants throughout Western Pennsylvania.

In 1986, WBZZ did extensive work with the local Roy Rogers restaurants to encourage safe driving over the Memorial Day Weekend, with the commitment to "buy lunch" for everyone if there were no fatalities in the County. For their part, the restaurants remained open late, and provided free coffee. WBZZ conducted an intensive promotional campaign, with public service announcements and numerous on-air mentions, encouraging safe driving. There were no fatalities that weekend, and Roy Rogers and WBZZ served lunch to and entertained approximately 6 - 8,000 people in a City park.



I believe that WBZZ is instrumental in helping to enhance Pittsburgh's image, through its promotions of local events, assistance to local organizations, and generally through its programming. STATEMENT OF GEORGE J. OMIROS

I have been the Executive Director of the Western Pennsylvania Chapter of the Leukemia Society of America since 1988. We are a non-profit organization dedicated to leukemia research and education. Our Chapter serves one third of Pennsylvania as well as all of West Virginia.

Our involvement with radio Station WBZZ goes back more than eight years. Throughout that entire period, WBZZ has been extremely supportive of our efforts. WBZZ's support has been expressed by broadcasting numerous public service announcements and by its participation in many of our most significant fund raising activities. In both ways, WBZZ has contributed substantially to public awareness of the Leukemia Society and of our efforts with respect to it. WBZZ's efforts and the personal efforts of WBZZ staff members have generated more than \$100,000 in contributions for us each year. WBZZ, to a greater extent than any other Pittsburgh radio station, goes out of its way to help us. Some of WBZZ's efforts on our behalf are outlined below.

- We have had Celebrity Waiters Luncheons for the past fifteen years, and WBZZ has been involved in twelve of them since 1988. At these luncheons, celebrities such as WBZZ on-air personalities serve lunch to people who contribute to our organization and serve as Master of Ceremonies.

- WBZZ has also participated in our Pittsburgh Bachelor Bids, which raise approximately \$30,000 for us each year, by recruiting "bachelors" and by having its personnel be "bachelors," who are auctioned off to the highest

bidder. WBZZ personalities have also been masters of ceremony at these functions. We have had Bachelor Bid affairs for the past seven years, and WBZZ has participated in them for the past six years. Largely through WBZZ's promotional efforts, these have been sell-outs ever since WBZZ became involved.

- WBZZ has also participated in our annual Chocolate Rendezvous, during which chocolate candy donated to us is sold. Attendance figures have climbed from 4,000 to 6,000 since WBZZ became involved.

- We also present an annual Gelatin Slide, during which celebrities slide into vats of jello in response to contribution pledges. WBZZ personalities have participated fully in these events, which raise approximately \$40,000 for us each year.


WBZZ has promoted each of these events heavily through public service announcements.

WBZZ has also been very effective in getting our more serious messages across, through its Dialogue program. These have included interviews with leukemia patients, family members of leukemia patients, bone marrow transplant recipients, and discussions of the nature of leukemia. Whenever WBZZ broadcasts a leukemia related program, we get calls from members of the public seeking additional information. One program done by Shelley Duffy generated 93 calls on the nature of leukemia and bone marrow transplantation.

Beyond leukemia, and our society, WBZZ also gets involved in similar ways with many other charitable organizations. Whenever it does,

WBZZ's involvement is 100 percent: when WBZZ makes a commitment, it exceeds its promises and then follows through. In my experience, WBZZ stands out in this respect amongst all of the radio stations in Pittsburgh. That has been my experience with WBZZ during my entire time with the Leukemia Society, and prior to that, during my years (1979 - 1988) with the American Heart Association in Pittsburgh.

STATEMENT OF C. RICHARD REDD

I am the Director of the Alcohol and Drug Program of United Mental Health, Inc. We are an advocacy organization and try to bring about changes in public health policy.

An important phase of my work involves youth. As a subcommittee of our Special Advisory Council on Alcohol and Other Drugs, we have a twenty member youth "strike force." WBZZ, as a youth-oriented station, has been of tremendous assistance to us in that area. For example, our strike force has, for the past five years, run an annual awareness contest for all schools, kindergarten through twelfth grade, in western Pennsylvania. Youth compete in that contest by submitting original works designed to create awareness of drug and alcohol related problems and to promote early intervention. In different years, they have submitted essays, poetry, slogans, bumper stickers, and rap compositions to be judged by our strike force. Last year, we received approximately 80,000 submissions. For the past five years, WBZZ has provided prizes and WBZZ personnel have participated actively in our awards presentations, not only by making the awards but by mingling with the young people present and serving as role models for them. WBZZ has also conducted and broadcast interviews, as well as numerous public service announcements, essays and other awareness materials, written by our young people. WBZZ has broadcast them at good times, after school and on weekends, when young people are likely to be listening.

WBZZ has provided all of the assistance we have sought, and more. It has provided more help with our youth program than all of the other radio and television stations in Pittsburgh combined. Our association with WBZZ has been one of the main factors which has made our efforts attractive to youth, and without WBZZ's help, our youth program probably would not have survived.

STATEMENT OF MARY PAT ROOT

I am the Executive Director of the Western Pennsylvania Chapter of the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, which was established in 1955 to raise funds to support cystic fibrosis research and to improve the quality of life of those afflicted with the illness.

WBZZ has been very supportive of our efforts. For the past eight years, WBZZ has been involved in our Annual Stair Climb and has been one of our radio sponsors. A copy of our 1989 Stair Climb brochure is attached to this statement, as are copies of letters detailing WBZZ involvement in 1989 and 1990. During this marathon-like fund raiser for the Foundation, contestants climb the stairs to the top of one of Pittsburgh's tallest buildings. The contestants are generally sponsored by local organizations.

Since 1991, WBZZ has worked with the St. Louise de Marillac Youth Ministry in its efforts to raise funds for the Foundation. A copy of a letter to the Foundation from the Youth Ministry director is attached to this statement.

WBZZ has also supported our Penguins at Your Service fund raiser since 1985, a gala event during which members of the Penguins, our local hockey team, wait on tables. WBZZ has donated autographed CDs, tapes and posters to be given away as prizes or to be auctioned. A copy of a program, from 1991, is attached to this statement. WBZZ has provided similar support for the American Airlines Tennis Auction Ball for the past eight years.

WBZZ provides numerous public service announcements and other support for our other activities as well. These include our Great Strides walk in South Park to support cystic fibrosis research, our Bowl USA event, and our 65 Roses Golf Tournament. A copy of our 1991 Golf Tournament brochure identifying WBZZ as our Radio Sponsor is attached to this statement. Jeff Tyson, of WBZZ,

was a member of the tournament committee. A promotional brochure mentioning WBZZ's involvement is attached to this statement, along with correspondence with Mr. Tyson and Mr. John Roberts, WBZZ's Program Director.

We generally approach WBZZ for help before going to any other radio station, because of its high level of commitment to the community and the excellent relationship we have with the station and with its on-air personalities. In that connection, Jeff Tyson, one of the WBZZ personalities, has been a member of the W. Pa. Chapter's Board for the past five years, has served as a liaison between WBZZ and the Foundation, and has acted as master of ceremonies at the Foundation's annual meeting and at many fund raising events.




