- April 24, 1987 Tamara Duduukavich, coordinator for Pittsburgh Clean City Committee, said that on clean city day over 3,000 volunteers will fan out and pick up about 15,000 bags of litter.
- May 04, 1987 Counselors discussed Pittsburgh Marathan with some people from the marathon.
- May 13, 1987 Jenny Miller of Pittsburgh Children's Festival, discussed the festival and its purpose.
- May 19, 1987 Jack Wagner, Councilman, discussed finding a source who will fund fireworks, because they are to be contained until council releases them.
