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

Certain shares of The Petroleum V. Nasby Corporation ("Nasby") stock held by Thomas L. Root (70.25 shares) are being transferred pursuant to the terms set forth in the attached letter of Thomas L. Root to Thomas F. Root dated June 23, 1989 wherein Thomas F. and Joanne L. Root agreed to purchase the shares of stock for consideration in the amount of \$28,000, which has been paid.

On May 31, 1989, Thomas L. Root transferred 50 shares of Nasby stock held by him as custodian for his minor children as gifts to his minor children (Kathy G. Root is custodian for the benefit of minor children Thomas P.J. Root (25 shares) and Leslie J.L. Root (25 shares)). On June 1, 1989, Thomas L. Root transferred 100 shares of stock he held individually as gifts to his minor children (Arlene M. Geer is the trustee of 100 shares of Nasby stock for the benefit of Thomas P.J. Root (25 shares), Leslie J.L. Root (25 shares) and Travis S.C. Root (50 shares), the minor children of Thomas L. and Kathy G. Root). On June 1, 1989, 50 shares of Nasby stock individually owned by Thomas L. Root were transferred by him to the licensee corporation for retirement of a corporate debt which he previously assumed. The stock is being held in treasury and will be available in the event Timothy J. Moore exercises his option pursuant to an Option Agreement dated December 31, 1989 (attached as part of Exhibit 3 to transferee's section).

On June 1, 1989, Kathy G. Root, the spouse of Thomas L. Root, transferred 25 shares of Nasby stock individually owned by her as a gift to her minor child, Travis S.C. Root (shares previously transferred by Thomas L. Root to Kathy G. Root who then transferred

the shares which Arlene M. Geer holds in trust as part of the 50 shares she holds for the benefit of Travis S.C. Root), leaving Kathy G. Root with 33 shares of Nasby stock owned by her individually (representing 7.3% of the total issued and outstanding stock of Nasby (450)) and the above-mentioned 50 shares of Nasby stock held by her as custodian for her minor children (representing 11.1% shares of the total issued and outstanding stock of Nasby (450)).
