Under consideration is a Motion for Immediate Production of Documents, filed January 4, 1994, by Raymond W. Clanton ("Clanton").

Clanton seeks the production of documents for which the attorney-client privilege have been asserted. In her filed written direct case, Loren F. Selznick ("Selznick") stated that she informed Joseph Dailey that based on her discussion with counsel, she was of the opinion that she did not need a written commitment letter from him.

The motion will be denied. Selznick did not disclose the contents of any documents she received from her attorney or even the substance of any conversation she had with him. Thus, she has not waived the privilege.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the Motion for Immediate Production of Documents, filed January 4, 1994, by Clanton IS DENIED.
