Lettering will be at least 14 lines tall, and proportioned accordingly. Station ID insertion will be synchronized to the incoming picture, and inserted in the baseband signal prior to modulation. Timing is derived from a countdown from the vertical synchronization pulses; insertion is by electronic keying to prevent overmodulation. The information is stored in read-only memory (ROM) to prevent data loss in the event of power loss.
